Dear Harvest Partners,

Warm Christian greetings from Bulgaria! Thank you for your concern and support for the ministry in Bulgaria. I would like to share with you some events that happened earlier this year in our region:

### Big Revival in the Lom Area

Pastor Boris shared with me some events that happened in his town. Within a 10-day time period, 16 people died from various events with 10 of them being young people. Two of the young ladies that passed away were from the COGOP church in Lom. The husband of the first young lady had been using drugs and on the way to their destination, he missed a curve in the road and the car hit a tree. The husband didn't have any major wounds but his wife was in critical condition. At the age of 25, she passed away 10 days later. The second young lady, who was also 25, died from cancer. Pastor Boris said that God began to open their spiritual eyes to see the spiritual condition of their town. He had a prayer service at his church where he invited the young people of Lom as well as people from the towns of Vidin, Montana, and other villages in the area to a big evangelism meeting. The meeting was a success as three young families received Jesus Christ as their Savior and many people were healed. Praise the Lord for His mercy!



### New Converts Water Baptism

We baptized 14 new converts at the Rousse church. It is always amazing to watch when new people decide to dedicate their life to Christ and serve Him for His glory.



### Youth Conference in Silistra

Back in April, many young people from 27 different churches in the area gathered together at the old cinema in Silistra. They invited their friends, mainly unbelievers. They had a wonderful day together presenting dramas, dancing, worshipping the Lord, and listening to a good message titled, "How to beat Goliath in our lives!" All participants were blessed and encouraged.



### Our Needs:

1. The church building in the town of Dve Mogily needs repairs on the roof and the walls. There is a big crack in the wall in the main hall. The foundation of the building has to be supported. We estimate that the repairs would cost around \$1,500.
2. The church van in Rousse, which we use for repairing the church buildings in the area, evangelism in the region, as well as many other church events, is very broken. The engine, the speed controls, rust on the outside and more need repairs. The National office wants to buy a new or second hand one in good condition, but it is very expensive at around \$10,000.
3. The new mission fields are in need of funds for renting halls, electricity and the support of the ministries. We have 3 new ministries and \$250 each would cover the support of them.
