NGO CHURCH REVIVAL SEMINARY

On Thursday, December 15th, I journeyed to the Ngo Center local church in the district of Ngo, in the department of Plateaux for a three-day Revival Seminary about the HOLY SPIRIT AND HIS WORK.

As soon as I arrived by bus on Thursday, the local Pastor and his committee warmly welcomed me. With a motorbike escort, we went to the home of the Pastor where I was a guest during the Revival.

That evening, I spoke on the fundamental Christian experience highlighting 3 main topics: the Conviction, the Repentance, and the Justification.



During the following days morning session, I continued to speak on the fundamental Christian experience. I highlighted 3 new topics which included the Regeneration or New Birth, the Sanctification, and finally the Holiness where I reminded the brethren that holiness is the command of our Lord. 1 Peter 1:16 says, "be ye holy, for I am Holy." I encouraged the brethren to have a whole-hearted pursuit of a life of Christ-likeness.

At the end of this session, those in attendance broke out into groups where they discussed and shared amongst themselves and prayed for mutual growth.



"Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God."

Friday evening, I spoke on the Holy Spirit and who He is and what His purpose is for believers. At the end of this teaching session, everyone again broke into their discussion groups. Afterwards, we gathered together for fervent prayer and many were baptized with the Holy Spirit.

Saturday, the message revolved around the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The attendees were organized into small groups for discussion and prayer for the manifestation of the gifts of the Holy Spirit among them. During the evening service, I continued the topic with the fruit of the Holy Spirit. After this session, we had a great time of worship to our Lord where we prayed fervently for the guidance of the Holy Spirit. The Lord confirmed His Word through the pouring of His Spirit on the assembly in prayer and operated wonders and miracles. The overall attendance was 60 people a day.

Sunday's service was marvelously animated by the young dancers, singers and the worship group, I preached a message entitled: Jesus Christ is my own global assurance. We had 12 people join the Church by covenant.



After the service, we went to the place that we bought land for the church at the entrance of the city. We stretched out our hands praying for a Christian willingness for building help that is estimated to be about \$8,500 dollars.



Saturday afternoon, I had the opportunity to visit the local pygmies' village where I gave a brief message and distributed salt and soaps to them. I told them that I would be back next year. I pray that God will open the doors for assistance in this opportunity to minister.

I would like to also bring your attention to a great need of the ministry in Congo-Brazzaville. I have been without a vehicle to use for the travel that ministry here requires. I have the opportunity to purchase a good second hand car for \$10,000. If you in your benevolence could help with \$3,000 to \$4,000, with what we have saved already, I would be able to make payments on this car. Thank you for consideration and great benevolence.
