Greetings from the National Overseer

Although we have faced multiple challenges this past year, our Liberian people are moving forward and are strong in the Lord. We truly recognize the hand of God has been upon us, and we are grateful for His divine protection and great grace. He has proved Himself faithful, just as He always has been.

Please allow me this opportunity to express our many thanks and appreciations for your faithfulness to pray, encourage, and support us all through the year. You, our Harvest Partners, are such a blessing. Thank you.

Despite the Ebola crisis, the church in Liberia still operates at full capacity with all local churches carrying on activities: Bible Studies, Prayer Meetings and Divine Worship Services as usual.

The church in Liberia was able to identify with victims of the EBOLA virus, and on October 28, 2014, the church (through members' donations/contributions from all local branches) donated assorted items worth L\$70,000 (Seventy thousand Liberian dollars is approximately \$756.76

US dollars) to the EBOLA treatment unit at the Island Hospital.

We are so grateful to your prayers. Thus far, to our knowledge, we have only had four church-related deaths due to the EBOLA.

The church in Liberia as indicated in the last update submitted in September 2014, is still soliciting
