At this present time, we are leasing two commercial units that we are using as a place of worship and also as a Community Center. The landlord has requested us to vacate the premises at the expiration of our lease, which will expire the middle of next year.


We have already paid to the Owners (Developers) of the building an initial deposit of Malaysian Ringgit. The International Office had helped us with a seed amount of money which contributed towards the payment of the initial deposit with the balance sum to be procured through a bank loan. I have also mortgaged my home and other members have contributed towards the payment of the initial deposit.

Our loan application has been rejected by the bank and according to the agreement that we signed with the owners, they can forfeit the total sum of the initial deposit paid to them if we do not procure the loan during the time stipulated. We did convey to the owners that we are a Church and we needed time to sign a new agreement to procure a loan and asked that they grant us a grace period. We also appealed that the initial deposit not be forfeited.

The owners have agreed not to forfeit our initial deposit provided we pay them an additional sum of money towards the purchase price which must be paid by the end of this month (November 30th, 2016) and they will then execute a new agreement providing us the necessary time to procure a loan from the bank. To procure a lesser sum of money from the bank is quite feasible as we have had discussions with them, who in principle have agreed to our proposal.

I am appealing to the kindness of our fellow churches to solicit funds for this need. I hope and pray during this crucial period of time that you will extend your helping hand to the COGOP Malaysia.
